What is 99-CVR?



This may be something you've heard about in passing, but have no idea what it means. The "CVR" acronym is for "Convention Resolution." CVR 17R is a resolution passed at AFTRA's bi-annual convention in San Francisco, in 1999. (Screen Actors Guild doesn't have conventions.)

The language below is the action resolution. It should be noted that the Screen Actors Guild National Board of Directors passed the same motion.

WHEREAS, actors and other performers will continue to be employed in both AFTRA and SAG jurisdiction;
and WHEREAS, differences may exist in wages and working conditions between contracts;

BE IT RESOLVED that the unions make every effort to coordinate with each other to compare and understand the provisions existing in each others' major contracts that may benefit performers;

and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the unions seek to bargain provisions THAT BENEFIT PERFORMERS
and, in their totality, raise terms and conditions for work under those contracts;

and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be effective upon its adoption by the Screen Actors Guild.
