

A NO VOTE MEANS NO

And that's all that it means.

A "No" vote IS NOT a vote for a strike on the AFTRA Primetime Exhibit A ballot.

AFTRA's National Executive Director sent an email stating that actors must either accept the AFTRA deal or go on strike. What about going back to the table? Is AFTRA saying they won't go back and bargain a better deal if AFTRA members vote this deal down?

The SAG National Negotiating Committee knows that a "No" vote makes a strike LESS likely because it shows that all actors want a better deal.

Just look at the actual ballot. There is no mention of a strike authorization on the ballot form itself.

A "no" vote **does not mean a vote for strike.**

Vote no on AFTRA's Primetime Exhibit A ballot and mail it today.
