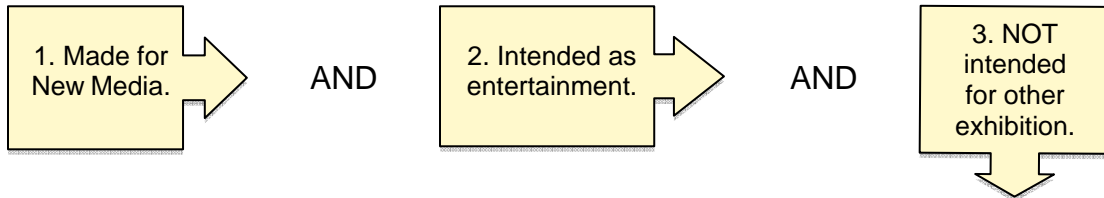


DIGEST FOR SCREEN ACTORS GUILD NEW MEDIA AGREEMENT

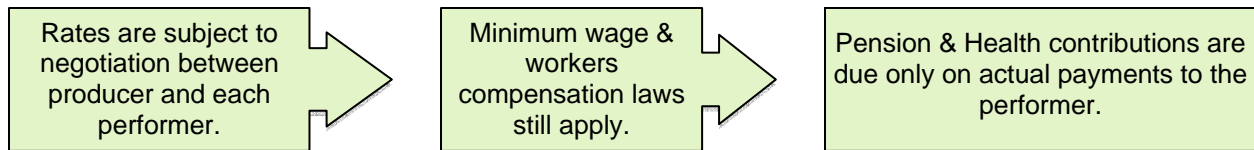
Projects made for New Media (Internet & mobile phones) fall under a SAG agreement and may fall under the terms of the New Media Agreement.

1. Does your project fall under the New Media Agreement?

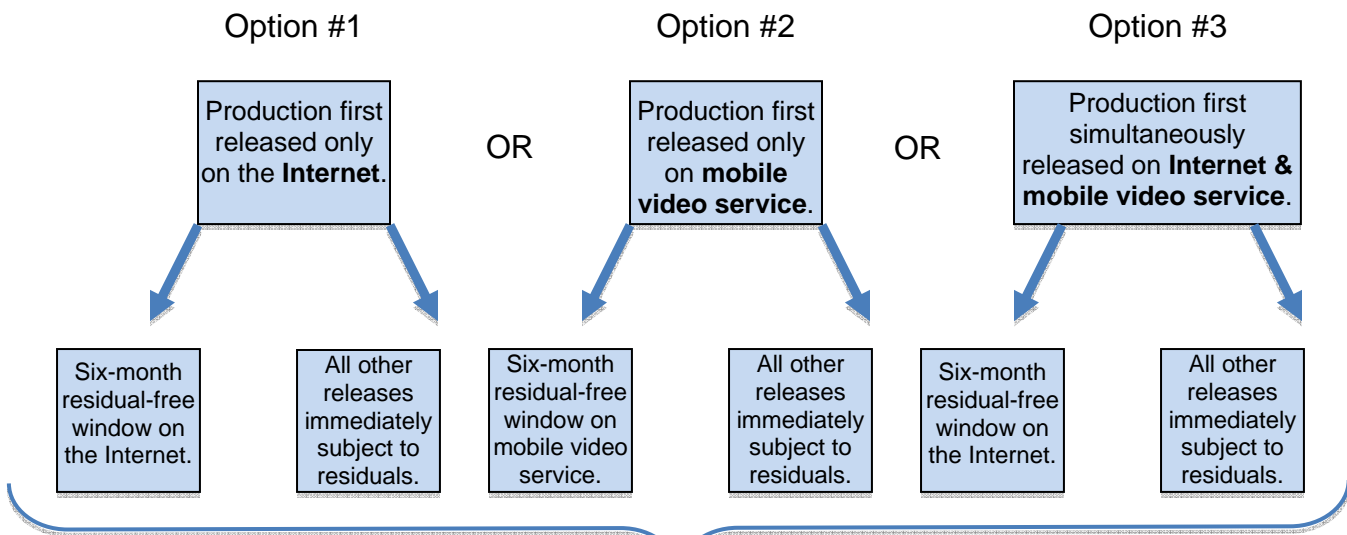


Then, a week prior to the production's start date, the producer must contact the Hollywood SAG office and provide a SAG representative with an information sheet about the project, a copy of the script and ID, a budget, and pre-production cast list. A packet of documents will then be sent for the producer's signature.

3. What about residuals and going to TV or somewhere else?



Any release outside the residual-free window requires payment to each performer of a pro rata share of 6% (plus Pension & Health) of the revenue paid to exploit the program, which includes any value received. Pension and Health contributions are due on all payments made to the performer.

- Exploitation or re-use in other mediums (i.e., TV) requires consent and triggers additional compensation.
- Note that accessing a program through a cell phone Internet browser shall constitute Internet distribution, not distribution via mobile video service (i.e., Vcast, Sprint TV, etc.).
