



## Welcome to the Young Performers Program at The Screen Actors Guild Conservatory!

The Conservatory provides opportunities for Young Performers to attend a 10-week curriculum twice a year and the opportunity to appear in non-paying student films at the American Film Institute by submitting headshots. The classes are taught by a combination of teachers. The Fall session **begins September 19**. We also have a special day long seminar once a year for both actors and parents. All classes are held on the AFI campus: 2021 N. Western Avenue, Hollywood, CA 90027.

**Call 323.856.7736 to reserve a space for Saturday Young Performers Workshops, which are usually held from 11-1 p.m. in Library Building Room 102. Reservations will be taken during office hours only which are 10-noon & 1-4 p.m., not by voicemail message or emails.**

In all classes, priority goes to young performers who are members of the Screen Actors Guild. However, if space is available, non-union actors will also be admitted.

**PARENTS:** Our Young Performers are expected to arrive on time and stay for the full session of the workshop. As a security precaution, please be sure your child checks in with the teacher or an assistant when they arrive and checks out as well before they leave.

It is our privilege for the SAG Conservatory to be able to work with the American Film Institute and use the campus for our programs. Please remember that we are guests here and must show respect through courteous behavior and keeping the noise level down. Very often AFI classes and filming are going on during our time on campus so we need to be particularly respectful while the filmmakers are doing their work. Should there be a behavior problem, we will speak with the actor. If the problem persists, we will speak with the parent. An ongoing problem may result in a student being asked not to attend further sessions.
