Amy Aquino was elected Screen Actors Guild's national secretary-treasurer on September 24, 2009. She is the primary elected liaison for the Guild's budgetary and financial matters, serves as chair of the Finance Committee and is a member of the Strategic Planning Committee and National Executive Committee.

A SAG member since 1987, Aquino is a familiar face who's been making her living as an actress for nearly 25 years. After earning her BA from Harvard and MFA from the Yale School of Drama, she spent five years in New York doing theater (on and off Broadway, and regionally) and appeared in films such as *Working Girl* and *Moonstruck*.

She relocated to Los Angeles to star as Phyllis Berger on the critically acclaimed *Brooklyn Bridge*, and went on to make countless guest appearances on other shows, including recurring roles on *ER*, *Everybody Loves Raymond*, *Judging Amy*, *Picket Fences*, *Felicity*, *Freaks and Geeks*, *Curb Your Enthusiasm*, *CSI* and *Crossing Jordan*, and was featured in the films *Boys on the Side*, *White Oleander*, *A Lot Like Love* and *In Good Company*. She also has returned to the stage, performing at the Mark Taper Forum, Geffen Theater and South Coast Repertory and in New York in Wendy Wasserstein's *Third* at Lincoln Center. Currently, Aquino can be seen on the ABC show *Brothers & Sisters*. Aquino appears in the upcoming film *In My Sleep*, which is scheduled to be released in February 2010.

Aquino previously served as a SAG officer for 11 years, including two terms as 1st vice president. She served on the Negotiating, Finance and Merger committees, among others, and was the Hollywood liaison to the Regional Branches. During her long tenure as chair of the Communications Committee, she spearheaded the creation of SAG's website, merchandising and Independent Film Outreach program, as well as the rebirth of *Screen Actor* magazine and the Hollywood Call Sheet.
