## SAG/WGAE FILM SOCIETY OF NEW YORK GUIDELINES FOR MEMBERS AND GUESTS

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

#### 1) ADMITTANCE/SEATING POLICY

- A) Admittance is by official **Film Society Membership Card ONLY**.  
No one will be admitted without a membership card.  
SAG members **MUST** present their paid-up SAG card if requested.
- B) Doors open 30 minutes prior to each screening, except when a film's running time causes a short turnaround. Members and guests (one guest per member) will be admitted in order of arrival. **Everyone must stand in line.** Regrettably, should capacity be reached, members not admitted will need to try another screening.
- C) Doors will close promptly at the scheduled screening time or when theatre capacity is reached. **No one will be admitted after the doors close.**
- D) There is **no re-admittance** if you leave the building after your card is scanned.

#### 2) GUEST POLICIES

- A) Only **ONE** guest per card may be admitted.
- B) Only the Film Society member, named on the card, is entitled to bring a guest.
- C) Guest must be at least 16 years of age.
- D) Guest must attend the same screening time slot as the Film Society member.
- E) Members arriving before their guest for a regularly scheduled film may leave **THEIR GUEST'S NAME** on the Courtesy Guest List. Guest **MUST** arrive before the doors close & stand on line.
- F) In the absence of the Film Society member, the regular guest (the guest who usually accompanies the member) would be admitted upon presenting the member's card. In this scenario, the guest, **and only the guest**, will be admitted. No additional guest will be admitted and no one else including the member may use the card for that film.
- G) At all bonus screenings there will be no Courtesy Guest List.  
All guests must enter with the member.
- H) **AT ALL TIMES THE MEMBER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS OF THEIR GUEST. DO NOT BRING STRANGERS INTO THEATRE.**
- I) The Film Society reserves the right to change the guest policy at any time.

#### 3) FILM SOCIETY ANNOUNCEMENTS

##### **A) HOTLINE\*\*\*212-827-1592 \*\*\* 24 HOURS \*\*\* 7 DAYS A WEEK**

The announcement will contain the following information as far in advance as possible:

- 1) The next scheduled film(s) or bonus films (if available).
  - 2) Any changes in screening times or screening dates.
  - 3) Cancellations due to severe weather conditions or unusual circumstances.
- B) Once a month E-Blasts will also be used for announcements,  
if you have provided the Film Society with your current e-mail address.
  - C) Twitter will also have tweets if you have signed up at @SAGflicksNY
  - D) The SAG web site will have a current schedule posted regularly

**4) THEATRE RULES TO REMEMBER**

- A) NO SMOKING. **NO FOOD OR DRINKS** including candy, gum, water.
- B) Please turn all pagers and cell phones to OFF, silent or vibrate.
- C) No text messaging during the running of the film.
- D) Restrooms, telephones and water fountain located on lower level.
- E) Please enter and be seated as quickly as possible. **No one may wait in lobby.**
- F) Please remain seated during the credits until the house lights come up.
- G) Once house lights come up, **please leave as quickly as possible.**
- H) If we do not have time to show entire credits please go to WWW.IMDB.COM.
- I) Please take everything with you when you leave the theatre, including papers and trash. Our continued use of this facility depends upon a clean theatre.  
Also note; we do not have a Lost & Found.

**5) PROCEDURES TO REPLACE A LOST/STOLEN FILM SOCIETY CARD**

- A) WGAE members please contact the Writers Guild.
- B) SAG members:
  - 1) GO to SAG committees' office and fill out Lost/Stolen report.
  - 2) Pay a processing fee of \$25.00 M/O or CHECK ONLY.
  - 3) You will pick your new card up **at the theatre**,  
presenting your photo ID & SAG card, at the next screening you attend.
  - 4) If your card will not be ready in time for a screening, your name will be left at the theatre. Please bring the receipt and photo ID.
  - 5) If your new card is not at the theatre please contact us within 14 days.

  - 6) If you find your old card PLEASE do not attempt to use it and destroy it.

**6) REMEMBER**

The Film Society uses the address, e-mail address and phone numbers listed with the union's membership department. If you need to change your address, please notify the membership department first, then the Film Society. Also, don't forget to notify the Pension and Health Office.

*When you mailed your Film Society application you agreed to abide by its operation rules and guidelines. Violation of these rules and guidelines, by either Film Society Member or GUEST, may result in the non-refundable cancellation of your membership for the current season and/or future seasons.*
